

**POSITION:** Golf Course Grounds Laborer

**REPORTS TO:** Golf Course Superintendent

**Position Summary:**

Under general direction from the Golf Course Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent or Crew Foreman, the Golf Course Grounds Laborer safely utilizes a variety of tools, machinery and equipment to perform maintenance duties around the golf course and grounds.

**Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Safely operate equipment and accessories as trained and assigned including, but not limited to, greens mowers, rotary mowers, flymos, tri-plex mowers, vertical mowers, line trimmers, edgers, utility vehicles, back-pack blowers, portable pumps, aerifiers, mechanical top dressers, sod cutters, mechanical bunker rakes, tractors, sweepers, blades, loaders, backhoes, trenchers, chain saws, and miscellaneous hand tools.
- Properly care for assigned equipment by inspecting machinery before and after each use, cleaning machinery after each use, making necessary minor adjustments to equipment and reporting machinery/equipment problems to the equipment technician.
- Perform daily maintenance tasks on the golf course and grounds as well as the maintenance facility and clubhouse as assigned and directed. Duties may include, but not limited to, mowing, loading and unloading materials, trimming trees, removing cuttings, laying sod, hand raking bunkers, drainage installation and repair, and repairing ball marks and filling divots.
- Perform golf course service and set up work as directed.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:**

- Knowledge of methods and materials used in grounds and landscape area construction/maintenance work.
- Working knowledge of and ability to use hand and power tools and equipment.
- Physical strength, stamina and agility.
- Ability to operate light motorized equipment.
- Ability to analyze and solve problems; efficiently handle multiple duties under pressure with minimal supervision; work flexible hours as required including nights/weekends.
- Positive attitude, professional manner and appearance in all situations.

**Physical Requirements:**

Must have the ability to:

- Communicate verbally with staff members and/or customers with or without the use of two-way radios.
- Give and/or follow verbal and written instructions
- Visually inspect all work areas, golf course and grounds
- See players on the golf course, and to follow the flight of golf balls
- Operate vehicles and equipment for several hours at a time
- Stand, sit, walk, push, pull, lift, grasp, bend and kneel for up to 5 hours at a time
- Lift up to 100lbs occasionally, 50lbs frequently, and 20lbs constantly
